It also celebrates how people and communities around world are reducing their exposure to disasters and raising awareness about the importance of reining in risks that they face. It also solicit to spread it around the world and also reduce exposure of people and communities.

UN General Assembly (UNGA) in 1989 had instituted International Day for Natural Disaster Reduction. to promote a global culture of risk-awareness and disaster reduction.

Earlier, this day was celebrated annually on the second Wednesday of October. But in 2009, the UNGA formally designated 13 October and changed its name to international day for disaster reduction by adopting resolution 64/200.

SEBI is managed by its board members and the management of the board is defined in Section 4 of the act, which consists of following:

- a Chairman who shall be appointed by the Cenral Government.
- two members from Ministry of Central Government dealing with Finance (and administration of the Companies Act, 1956).
- one member from the Reserve bank of India.
- five other members appointed by central government, out of them at least three shall be whole time members.
